Take a ride on the funicular to the Upper Town of Old Quebec where you will find the majestic Château Frontenac and over 400 years of history greeting you against the backdrop of the St. Lawrence River. Explore the medieval-style fortifications and walk the historic Dufferin Terrace, learning how this UNESCO World Heritage city evolved from a French fortress to a vibrant cultural center.
